		4.2	Review conditions and criteria for external funding and communicate findings to other relevant people.
		4.3	Engage relevant internal and external expertise to assist with the preparation of the bid/tender.
		4.4	Develop a tender/bid that meets the identified requirements of the funding source.
		4.5	Gain feedback from relevant people on the draft bid/tender and revise accordingly.
		4.6	Submit the funding application to the funding source within specified timescale.
		4.7	Provide any additional information and clarifications that the funding source requires.
		4.8	Keep accurate records about the preparation of the bid/tender.
